Donated squares can be any size and should include a red fabric with a PURE WHITE background.

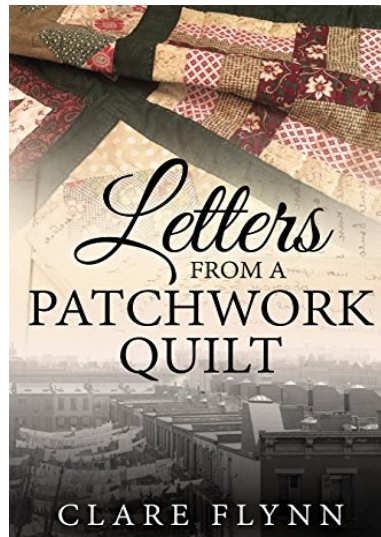
We still have fabric kits available if you want one or have time for extras
